



What is Biblical Clarity?

And is this a repetition of a previous article?


Biblical Clarity is the understanding that God plainly communicates His thoughts to us through the Bible's words.

That was the start of an **ICR article** we included in our **August 2018 DSA newsletter.**

In a recent article, ICR President Randy J. Guliuzza, P.E., M.D. explains further...

"The Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God" has been affirmed repeatedly from pulpits. But did you know this important declaration presupposes two other essential doctrines of the Bible? These are biblical preservation and clarity.

Preservation means that God has supernaturally safeguarded the information He wanted in His Bible all the way from Moses, and perhaps Adam himself, to now. Clarity affirms that anybody can understand the plain message of Bible passages such as "for in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them" (Exodus 20:11). In comparison to the doctrine of inspiration, clarity and preservation seem to get little respect, but they are equally important truths. After all, what good is a God-breathed book to a Christian if it's either unintelligible or can't be found?



It's easy to understand the doctrine of biblical clarity (technically called perspicuity) when we strip away the theological jargon. It means that God clearly communicates what He wants to say to people at any time and in any culture when they can read an accurate translation of the Bible. The average person who doesn't have an advanced

degree in science or theology can attain a clear understanding of what the Bible means. In short, with nothing more than our own reading of the Bible's words, Christ clearly communicates His thoughts to us—regardless of whether we are a religious cleric or a hotel clerk.

In memory of Frank M. Watts, DVM

On a 1990 trip to an ICR workshop in California, retired veterinarian Frank Watts and his wife Ina were inspired to start a local organization to promote the scientific evidence that corroborates the Biblical narrative of the earth's natural history. The first meeting of DSA was held in October, 1990 at Sunnyside Community Church.

Frank was born in Prince Rupert, B.C. in 1921. He moved with his family to Kelso, Washington where he graduated high school in 1939. Putting college studies on hold for WWII, Frank enlisted in the Army in January 1942. Overall, he participated in five amphibious beach landings and eight military campaigns from Casa Blanca to French Morocco to Algeria to Tunisia, and from Sicily to Anzio to Rome to Southern France to the Rhineland and to central Europe and Germany.



After the war Frank continued his education, graduating from Washington State University with a Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine. While managing five children and a full time career, he studied at Multnomah School of the Bible, graduating in 1969 with a Degree in Theology.

Frank and his first wife Leona had a loving, wonderful 25 years together until her passing in 1977.

In 1978 he married Ina and they shared their mutual love of serving in The Gideons until her passing in 2004.

In his professional career, Frank served with Multnomah County and also as Veterinarian for the city of Portland, receiving distinguished recognition from the CDC for handling of a rabies problem in the early 70's

He was a great pianist and loved playing his piano for most of his life.

Frank is survived his and Leona's five children, Dale Watts, Karen Brosnan, Brian Watts, Barbara Bosch, Brenda Vahdat and eight grandchildren.
