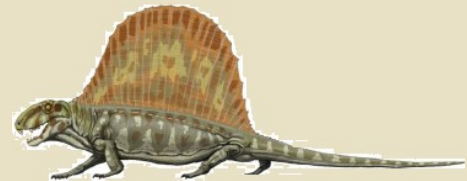

Digging in the Permian: The Secrets of Dimetrodon



Electron microscopist
and dinosaur researcher

Dr. Mark Armitage will speak in person at **Mount St. Helens Creation Center** Saturday evening **November 13** at 7 pm. Dimetrodon is not technically a dinosaur but a “pelycosaur,” an extinct group of reptiles said to have pre-dated the dinosaurs

by some 40 million years. Mark reveals secrets about these strange creatures that tell a very different story however - one that fits in well with a recent creation and a global flood. Actual bones will be on display and free children’s books will be given away. This is a free event but an offering will be taken to support the ongoing research of the **Dinosaur Soft Tissue Research Institute**

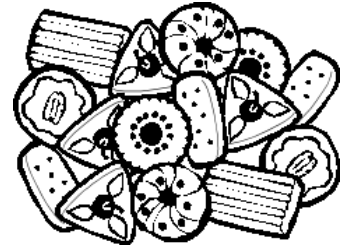

Eyewitness to the Creation Event?

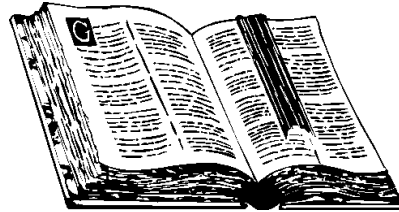
Actually, there is one. **God** was there and tells us about how and when He created everything.
